## WHO IS ELIGIBLE TO ATTEND?

Applicants must:

- Be between the ages of 14-17
- Have a sincere desire to learn about EMS
- Be mentally, physically, and emotionally able to participate in all camp activities.

## REGISTRATION

- Due online or by mail by June 1st
- Limited to the first 50 accepted applicants
- You will receive follow up information via email once application is accepted
- A parent/camper information night will be held prior to camp

## WHAT IS REQUIRED IF I AM ACCEPTED?

- 6 day/5 night commitment of your time
- 100% commitment to participate, learn and fully engage in the Camp EMS experience
- Adherent to all policies and guidelines
- Stay on campus the duration of camp.
