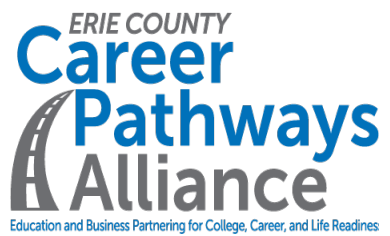

 - Welding/fabrication background preferred

- Relevant mechanical background preferred
- Mechanical equipment service apprentice
 - Approx. \$17 per hour with benefits
 - Apprentices take a 10-week HVAC/service class with "ride along" requirements. Then apprentices begin on-the-job training and work
 - HVAC/refrigeration service and maintenance background preferred
 - Electrical background preferred

- Apprentices earn college credits which can be used towards an Associates of Science degree
- Apprentices receive high level training

- Apprentices visit our International Training Center in Las Vegas
- Apprenticeships are “earn as you learn” opportunities; apprentices earn good wages during their apprenticeships, not debt

Disqualifications:

- Non-citizen of USA without a green card
- Member of another construction union

Entry-level positions:

- Commercial Roofing Apprentice
 - \$17.62 per hour
 - Works on commercial rooves

Other information:

- Apprentices receive a starting wage that is 55% of the wage of a journeyworker
- After 500 hours, the apprentice advances to 60% (\$19.22 per hour), plus receives medical insurance and contributions to two different pension plans
- Then, every 1000 hours, the apprentice's pay increases by 10%, equating to about \$3.20 per hour raise
- Once the apprentice reaches 100%, they will earn \$32.03 per hour plus \$17.18 per hour in benefits, totaling \$49.21 per hour
